

MENDOCINO WINEGRAPE & WINE COMMISSION ASSESSMENT BREAKDOWN

MENDOCINO COUNTY GROWERS

DUE: JULY 15th

GROWER BASE FEE ASSESSMENT FORM 1

Grower base fee is calculated on tonnage marketed (including custom crush) to both Mendocino vintners as well as out of county vintners from the previous year's harvest

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78921(a)]

DUE: DECEMBER 15th

CUSTOM CRUSH ASSESSMENT FORM 5

Grape growers are required to pay \$10 per ton on all custom crush tons processed at either the time of sale of the wine or by 1 year sunset after the crush date.
(no later than December 15)

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78801]

MENDOCINO COUNTY VINTNERS

DUE: JULY 15th

VINTNER BASE FEE ASSESSMENT FORM 2

Vintner base fee is calculated on Mendocino County tons of own (estate or any ton under the winery entity) processed and marketed from the previous year's harvest

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78921(c)]

DUE: DECEMBER 15th

VINTNER TONNAGE ASSESSMENT (Remitted on behalf of the Grower) FORM 3

Bonded Mendocino County vintners collect \$10 per ton from each Mendocino County ton purchased and remit payment and reporting on grower's behalf.

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78921(b)]

DUE: DECEMBER 15th

VINTNER TONNAGE ASSESSMENT FORM 4

Bonded Mendocino County vintners remit \$10 per ton on each ton of own fruit (estate or any ton produced under the winery entity) that they process.

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78921(d)]

DUE: DECEMBER 15th

VINTNER CUSTOM CRUSH REPORT Form: CC

Vintners must report custom crush activity to the Commission but shall not be required to remit an assessment if the producer has not been paid for the winegrapes or the resulting winegrape product.

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78924 (a)]

OUT OF COUNTY VINTNERS

DUE: DECEMBER 15th

VINTNER TONNAGE ASSESSMENT (Remitted on behalf of the Grower) FORM 3

Out of County vintners collect \$10 per ton from each Mendocino County ton purchased and remit payment and reporting on the grower's behalf

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78921(b)]

DUE: DECEMBER 15th

VINTNER CUSTOM CRUSH REPORT Form: CC

Vintners must report custom crush activity to the Commission but shall not be required to remit an assessment if the producer has not been paid for the winegrapes or the resulting winegrape product.

[California Food and Agriculture Code Section 78924 (a)]
